1. Contact hours per week

- hours of German classes 15
 - (20 lessons / week à 45 min. international groups with max. 12 students per class)
- hours seminar on German culture or a German movie with teacher introduction every 2 Thursday afternoon
- 8 two half-day excursions in Berlin with GLS guide
- 8 hours full-day excursion in Berlin or to Hamburg, Dresden, Leipzig, Potsdam with GLS guide
- 33 hours (= 60 minutes) per week
