ASHFORD SCHOOL

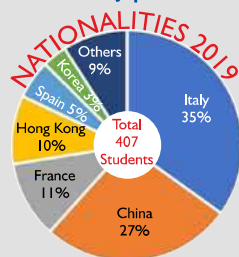
Ashford School, founded in 1898, is one of the UK's top boarding schools
