LIVING

- Single en-suite rooms arranged in flats of 6-8 students
- Communal space in each flat

FOOD OPTIONS

Breakfast

Continental breakfast available including juice, tea, coffee, toast, jams, cereal, pastries and fruit.

Lunch

Three courses, 2 main course options including a vegetarian option.

Packed lunch (provided at week end): This will consist of a sandwich, water, fruit and / or chocolate.

Evening Meal

Three courses, 2 main course options including a vegetarian option.

Snacks

There are several shops nearby to purchase snacks, drinks and confectionary.

Facilities

- Indoor sports hall
- Communal space in each flat
- Nice courtyard at the learning centre
- Large common area on the ground floor of the accommodation building and as well as a terrace
- All classrooms have interactive whiteboards

Meals are served in New City College dining hall.



LEARNING

- Taught by friendly and professional English teachers
- 20 x 45 minute lessons per week morning or afternoon
- Placement test on day 1 to ensure students in appropriate level
- Maximum 15 students per class
- Students will be placed in an international class with students of different nationalities
- Spacious modern classrooms located a short walk from the accommodation
- Curriculum with emphasis on communication skills
- Materials included as well as an end of course report and certificate

PROGRAMME INFORMATION

Arrival

Students will be welcomed upon arrival to UAL Will Wyatt Court Residence where they will register and get their room keys so that they can check-in to their rooms.

Welcome

On the first evening there will be a welcome activity which is designed to ensure students have the opportunity to meet staff and other students and get to know more about the centre, its facilities and useful information which will help them during their stay.

Activities

Activities are organised every day, these activities take place either on-site or near the centre. These may include:

- **Sports** such as football, mini Olympics, rounders, table tennis, volleyball and basketball
- **Daytime activities** such as Thames River Cruise, St Paul's cathedral, Tower Bridge, scavenger hunts, drama workshops, British Museum etc.
- **Evening activities** such as karaoke, talent show, film night, South Bank by night etc.

EXCURSIONS AND TRIPS

FULL-DAY

- Brighton: A vibrant, popular seaside resort with beautiful architecture with a visit to the Sea Life Centre.
- Canterbury: Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, this is one of the most visited cities in the UK with medieval buildings, including the gothic architecture of Canterbury Cathedral.
- Cambridge: An iconic university city famous for its colleges where students will visit King's College.

HALF-DAY TRIPS

Our students get to explore exciting places around London every weekday, visiting places such as: the British Museum, St Paul's Cathedral, Tower Bridge experience, the National Gallery, Leicester Square and Chinatown.

OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS/ACTIVITIES

- Thorpe Park: A popular theme park with extreme rides and attractions.
- Oxford: One of the most famous university towns, students will visit one of the colleges.
- Windsor Castle: The oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world.
- Afternoon activities: Students can visit the world-famous London Eye, Madame Tussauds and London Dungeon.
- Evening activities: Students choose to go bowling, go to the cinema, or even see a musical!
