Our Classic program has fixed start dates and runs for two weeks only, however, if you'd like to study for longer, talk to your advisor about our other course options. We can tailor a package for you.



BATH

The natural hot springs and the exquisitely preserved Roman baths built over them have kept travelers visiting Bath for over 2000 years. Nearby beauty spots include the dramatic Cheddar Gorge and the mysterious tor of Glastonbury.

Our English school is a classic Georgian building in the historic city center – within a five-minute walk of the Roman Baths and the medieval Abbey.

ACTIVITIES
