



The performing Arts Plus Programme is a fantastic way for students aged 10-17 year-old who have a keen interest in drama and dance to develop their skills and build friendships, all while becoming more confident and fluent using English in these authentic contexts. This programme welcomes students of all skill levels and experience.

### Key facts

- Performing Arts: 6 hours per week (Tuesday-Wednesday-Friday)
- English lessons: 20 lessons per week (15 hours)
- Activities & Day trips: 1 full day trip, 2 half day activities/trips, 5 evening activities, plus weekend activities
- Age range: 10-17 years
- Available with: London Classic City and Frensham Classic Country
- Course duration: minimum 1 week

### Course details

- Develop all four English language skills (Reading-Writing-Listening-Speaking) with the support of professional, qualified and friendly EC teachers
- All lessons and activities work together and each week covers a different theme. What is learnt in class is linked with activities outside of the classroom, hence learners get to use and practise their skills every single day!
- Build confidence with dance and drama professionals
- Prepare, practice and perfect a dance routine during the sessions before a grand performance at the talent show. Dance styles include contemporary, jazz, ballet and street dance.
- The drama sessions allow students to bring out their inner self. Under the tuition of an experienced tutor, students will put together a performance based on the weekly theme. They may be performing Shakespeare, or learning about stage combat, all under the tuition of our experience tutor.
- All coaching is in English and so students will improve their confidence and conversational English during their training
- Show off your skills at the weekly EC Talent show
- Develop technique, choreography and creative expression
