Day	Date	Excursion
Wednesday	11 July	<p>London</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sightseeing walking tour where students will see Westminster Abbey, the Houses of Parliament, Big Ben, Downing Street etc. Visit to the National Gallery - a famous art museum that exhibits many works of art including some by Vincent Van Gogh. Time in Covent Garden to explore the markets, shop and watch the street entertainment.
Friday	13 July	<p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a punting tour on the river Cam.
Sunday	15 July	<p>Chessington</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Family theme park near London with exciting rollercoasters and rides, as well as a zoo and sea life centre.
Wednesday	18 July	<p>Cadbury's World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A chocolate factory where visitors can learn almost everything there is to know about chocolate, from manufacturing and packing to advertising and tasting! Students will also be able to visit the world's biggest Cadbury's shop and go on a 4D chocolate adventure.
Friday	20 July	<p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a visit to King's College – one of Cambridge University's world famous colleges.
Sunday	22 July	<p>Brighton</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit to the Sea Life Centre (aquarium). Time to see the Royal Pavilion and Brighton Pier, a traditional British seaside resort.
Wednesday	25 July	<p>London</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sightseeing boat cruise along the river Thames where students will see many London sights including Tower Bridge, the Shard, Globe Theatre, Houses of Parliament, London Eye and Big Ben! Visit to the Natural History Museum – home to hundreds of exciting exhibits including many items collected by Charles Darwin. Highlights include the dinosaur gallery and the full size model of a blue whale.
Friday	27 July	<p>Bowling</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Off-site ten-pin bowling afternoon.
Sunday	29 July	<p>Warwick Castle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> An impressive mediaeval castle where students can experience 1,000 years of history. Attractions within the castle include jousting and falconry as well as the castle's impressive interiors, gardens and the opportunity to climb the battlements.
Wednesday	01 August	<p>Oxford</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Walking tour of the City and University. Entrance into the famous Christ Church College and Cathedral, with the chance to see the college dining hall where Harry Potter was filmed.
Friday	03 August	<p>Cambridge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Including a punting tour on the river Cam.
