



Residential Accommodation

Ashford School Boarding Houses



Brooke & Refuge House

33 beds to include students, staff and Group Leaders. Two common rooms, WIFI and a payphone is available.



Brabourne House

62 beds to include students, staff and Group Leaders. Two common rooms, WIFI and a payphone is available.



Alfred House

63 beds to include students, staff and Group Leaders. Three common rooms, WIFI and a payphone is available.



Bridge House

20 beds to include students, staff and Group Leaders. Large common room, WIFI and payphone is available.

Room allocations

The Centre Manager will create a bed plan for all residential students in the school. Certain rooms are reserved for staff and Group Leaders to ensure there is supervision in the boarding houses.

Students are allocated to residential accommodation according to the following criteria:

1. Gender
2. Age
3. Requests to share
4. Nationality

Houses are allocated to boys and girls as needed. Groups will be divided between houses - do not expect to have your group all in one building.

Wake up and Bedtime

Students will be woken up each morning at 07.10am and bedtime is between 22.00pm and 23.00pm depending on age. The Centre Manager will explain this in more detail. **Group Leaders are expected to assist residential staff with ensuring their students are in bed at night time.**

Cleaning & Maintenance

Bedrooms normally cleaned on Tuesday's and Thursday's. Communal areas cleaned Monday to Friday. No cleaning at weekends apart from rooms being prepared for new arrivals. Please inform the CM if there are any problems with any of the accommodation, including maintenance. Cleaners will not clean untidy rooms.

Laundry & Towels

Each house has its own washing machines and dryers and these can be used at any time by students and Group Leaders. The CM will explain this to you nearer the time. Sheets and bedding will be changed on a Tuesday. Ashford School **does not** provide towels so all students and GLs need to bring their own.

Catering

All meals will be taken in the school dining hall. Breakfast is from 07.30am to 08.30am (07.00am to 08.00am on excursion days). Lunch is from 12.30pm to 13.30pm with packed lunches provided for full day excursions. Dinner is from 18.30pm to 19.30pm each day. Students will have mealtimes on a rota basis and the CM will explain this in more detail. Typically it looks like this.
