Why choose Homestay?

Students who choose to study at Edinburgh School of English are joining our academic family and it is important for us that you are as comfortable outside of class as you are within it.

When you choose homestay accommodation you are choosing to stay with a local host family who are trusted by the school to welcome you into their home and provide you with a genuine Scottish experience during your stay.

Homestay accommodation provides an excellent opportunity for you to practice your English with native speakers outside of the classroom and students who choose to stay in a homestay find it easier to develop their speaking and listening skills.

How do we choose our hosts?

Our host families reflect our school, and we choose them with the same level of care and attention that we choose our teachers. Each host family is visited regularly by our Accommodation Officer to ensure they meet the high standards we require and regular host family events at the school make them feel part of the Edinburgh School of English family.

What is included?

Homestay accommodation is provided on a half board basis and includes breakfast and dinner with your host family. Please let us know about any special dietary requirements when making your booking.

You will have your own private room with a shared family bathroom. Rooms with private ensuite facilities are available on request for a weekly supplement.



Location and Transport

The city of Edinburgh is built around Edinburgh Castle. The city centre mainly consists of flats with larger houses further out. While we do try and place our students in families as near to the school as possible we take into account the student's age, interests and personality to ensure the best possible experience.

Our hosts are within a 30 minute bus journey of the school and those that require you to take a bus are located near to regular bus routes that stop close to the school.
